Faith Community Nursing (formerly Parish Nursing) is a health promotion, disease prevention role based on the care of the whole person and encompassing seven functions: integrator of faith and health, health educator, personal health counselor, referral agent, trainer of volunteers, developer of support groups, and health advocate.
